1980-1989

The 1980s began with implementing themes such as “Visions of the Future” and “Challenge of the 1980s for Youth and Women”. The National President, Mona H. Bailey, was the Chapter’s honored speaker for the 1981 Founder’s Day Forum and Scholarship Award Ceremony.

In recognition of the two million plus Black female heads of households, the Chapter began awarding scholarships to Black female heads of household who were pursuing academic goals. A scholarship is provided to a single head of household who is currently enrolled in a junior college or a four-year college. The four-year scholarship (Delores Bryant Scholarship) was established in memory of our Soror whose community service record was above outstanding.
